Who Should Attend? If you are part of a team that provides AT services in a public school setting, then this course is right for you. Participants include SLPs, OTs, teachers, school administrators and others who are members of their agency's AT teams.

About the Class: In this online class, we will challenge you to move forward and address the changing role of AT teams. Course activities including webinars, video recordings, and online discussion forums will give you an opportunity to analyze your current service model, focus on improving service delivery, use more online tools to increase efficiency and data collection, build agency-wide capacity, and plan effective outreach. Course discussions will provide time to share thoughts and ideas. You will identify areas of need, rethink the vision for your AT services, and create a multi-faceted 3-year plan.

Outcomes

Participants will:

- develop and articulate a vision for their teams' AT services
- create a 3-year plan for improving AT services
- identify ways to increase access to information about AT and restructure professional development
- identify new ways to build the capacity of the educators to independently provide AT services.

AT team members are encouraged to attend together. Whether you are an individual AT practitioner or part of a local school-based AT team, you will leave with a clear, detailed plan to move into the next decade of AT services.
